Working together for change

The tragedy of addiction ravages families and erodes the foundation of our culture. To effectively address the issues surrounding men caught in the cycle of the addiction, Riverton Place offers a “multifaceted” approach to recovery that involves family, community and local churches.

The Ministry of Riverton Place

- **The Genesis Project** is a nine-month residential discipleship and addiction recovery program for men. Through counseling and Biblical studies, men are equipped with the word of God and the tools necessary to deal with their addiction.
- **The Exodus Project** is a 90-day transitional program to help men move back into the community after graduating from the Genesis Project.
- **The Christian Service Intern program** is a one-year internship for graduates of the Genesis Project who would like to enter into full-time Christian service.
- **Certified Chemical Dependency Treatment** provided by our Chemical Dependency Professionals help men at Riverton Place deal with the challenges they face. Approved by the Washington State Department of Social and Health Service, Division of Alcohol and Substance Abuse as a Certified Treatment Service, we can provide DUI Assessments, Intensive Outpatient and Outpatient services to men enrolled in our residential discipleship and addiction recovery program.
- **Families are included.** Riverton Place approaches the needs of both the men and their families. Family Day is held on the 2nd Saturday of each month at 10:30 am. The program ends with a lunch at noon. Informed and educated families are essential to the continued recovery of the men we serve. On Family Day, our staff offer an opportunity for the families and friends of our residents to become better equipped to support their loved ones in recovery.

For the Community

- **Commencement**

Celebration takes place on the last Tuesday of every month. Riverton Place holds a commencement celebration for those who have completed the program and to celebrate what God is doing in the lives of our other residents. Dinner is served at 6:00 p.m. and the program begins at 6:45 p.m. If you would like to celebrate with us, please call Riverton Place for directions.



- **A Men's Prayer Breakfast** is held on Saturday mornings (except for the 2nd Saturday). The men of Riverton Place host a men's prayer breakfast at 9:00 am. A guest speaker and a great meal combine to make this time a special blessing to all who attend. This is an opportunity for our residents to develop friendships with godly men in the local church.
