



Survey Map of the Duwamish River (circa 1910)

This map was discovered in the archives of the City of Tukwila. It has been digitized and restored and printed on a 5 foot canvas. The land claims are delineated on the original and additional information about the Duwamish mythic sites has been added as well as the City of Tukwila logo and the salmon, symbol of the Duwamish, drawn in traditional Coastal Salish style. This survey was taken at the beginning of the dredging and straightening of the Duwamish River, an act which prompted the incorporation of Tukwila in order to preserve our quality of life and to protect the river from further commercial development within the Tukwila City limits. Fortunately the reconfiguration of the river stopped short of the key mythic sites on the river which relate to the Epic of the Winds. The incorporation of Tukwila in 1908 ensured that these sites would not be disturbed.
